Wildlife Conservation Up Close

Glauer Tal Game Reserve is NOT a classic game park. It is a nature conservation project with hiking trails. Our four-legged landscapers are wild animals and are meant to remain so. This way, they gladly keep their distance and you can observe the animals almost as if they were in the wild.

Even if it seems tempting, do not leave the paths. In addition to ensuring peace and safety for our wild animals, this is also about your safety: the area, as a former military training ground, has not been completely cleared of ammunition. Additionally, many open spaces are important habitats for endangered species precisely because of their untouched state.

The Command Tower—A Testament to History

Visit the former command tower and enjoy a unique view over the open landscape of the reserve. On the ground floor, you can experience a small exhibition on various landscape conservation concepts, exploration games, and some animal specimens.

Our Tip for a Great Experience:

Don't Forget Your Binoculars!

The animal inhabitants of the reserve are shy. That's why a free telescope is installed on the command tower. Feel free to bring your own binoculars! If you forget them, you can borrow a pair at the nature park centre.
